

# Village Rebroadcasts Dissolution Meeting

POTSDAM - Now that the village board has formally voted to place the issue of dissolution of the village on the ballot for Nov. 8, the consortium of civic organizations that arranged for the filming of the Sept. 12 public hearing is continuing to rebroadcast the one-hour, 34-minute event.

The next two rebroadcasts will take at 7:30 p.m. Monday and Tuesday on WCKN, Time Warner Channel 30.

The civic partners, the St. Lawrence County American Association of University Women, the League of Women Voters and the Potsdam Chamber of Commerce, and WCKN's North Country Matters, will continue to develop voter education programming about this issue over the next several weeks.

Village voters are urged to watch the hearing, attend public meetings, and educate themselves about all the options prior to Election Day.
